2. Artworks should be delivered, along with a copy of this form, to Ormonde Cottage, Hill Lane SG18 9EP, between 10am and 4pm from Monday 6th to Friday 10th September. Ormonde Cottage is next to the old main entrance to Shuttleworth. Enter the staff car park and knock on the door of Ormonde Cottage. We regret that we are unable to accept digital submissions of photographs. Please see our 'Information and Rules' sheet for further information about how your artwork should be presented and how to pay the entry fee (£5 per artwork for adults; children free).
